Once you are retired, you may obtain a Retiree Mountaineer Card from the Mountaineer Card Office. The card office is located at ERC, Bennett Tower, room G118. Please call the card office at 293-CARD (2273) to ensure required information is in their system before traveling to the card office. To obtain information on Senior Mountaineer Temps, a temporary staffing service of the WVU Division of Human Resources, contact 293-5700 x1.

MEDICARE ELIGIBILITY AND PEIA RETIREE HEALTH INSURANCE

When eligible for Medicare (generally, the first of the month you attain age 65), and covered by PEIA retiree health insurance, you must be enrolled in Medicare Parts A and B. If you are disabled, the Social Security Administration will enroll you in Medicare Parts A & B automatically (after receiving disability for two years) and you *must* provide a copy of your Medicare card to PEIA. The same requirements apply to anyone covered as a dependent on your PEIA retiree health coverage. Neither you nor your dependents need to, or should, enroll in Medicare Part D.

If you or your covered dependent(s) do not enroll in Medicare Parts A and B when required, PEIA will not pay what Medicare would have paid if you were properly enrolled in Medicare. PEIA becomes your secondary coverage when eligible for Medicare, whether or not you choose to enroll in Medicare.

If you have PEIA premium credits from leave and/or teaching service which may extend beyond your Medicare eligibility, you still must enroll in Medicare Parts A & B and pay the applicable monthly Medicare premium. Please contact the Social Security Administration for Medicare enrollment information (www.ssa.gov or 800.772.1213).
